

No-regret moves (do these now)

- Formalize a two-stage approval (editor \rightarrow owner)
- 102 Implement performance SLOs (e.g., LCP < 2.5s, INP < 200ms) with monitoring
- O3 Define access tiers and audit cadence
- Document integration/data flows (PII handling, consent)

If/then triggers



If editors >10 or conflicts persist → adopt Branching across high-change templates



If IT requests central access → implement SSO/SCIM



If 5+ locales or regional teams → build Localization governance



If contracts cite uptime/ response → negotiate SLAs




